WHY ELECTRICAL SAFETY IS SO IMPORTANT

- According to OSHA and BLS from 2011 2021, 118 occupations were involved in electrical fatalities - 69% were <u>non-electrical</u> occupations.
- Cause of Electrical Fatality, All Workers:
 - Contact with overhead power lines: 45.7%
 - Working on or near energized conductors / energized parts: 44.9%
 - Lockout / tagout procedure failure or safety controls removed: 8.4%
 - Other: 1%
