Cement Safety Protect Your Skin and Eyes



Cement (wet or dry) is Caustic to your skin and eyes. It can cause burns, rashes, and irritations. Protect your skin and eyes by doing the following:

- Protect your hands with well-fitted gloves when mixing and applying. Avoid allowing cement to enter inside the glove.
- Do not use cotton or leather gloves. Use butyl, nitrile, or other approved glove. Refer to the cement material safety data sheet (MSDS) for selecting proper glove.
- Avoid allowing cement to saturate your gloves and clothing. Wash contaminated gloves and clothing and allow gloves and clothing to dry before using.
- Wear approved eye protection at all times.
- Wash your hands and other skin area that has come into contact with the cement.
