## **GOLF CART SAFETY**

- Drivers and passengers must remain seated and seat belted at all times while moving.
- Never exceed the number of passengers for the number of designated passenger seats.



Keep all body parts inside the golf cart driver and passenger areas.



- Operate at a safe speed that does not exceed a well-paced walk.
- Slow down when approaching pedestrians and give them the right of way.
- Slow down when turning, traveling on inclines, slippery surfaces and hazardous conditions.
- Never try to get on or off a golf cart that is moving.
