## When approaching the dump location:

- Observe the entire dump area.
- Pick a location to dump and decide the direction you want to turn.
- Before backing- inspect for slump, soft spots and adequate berms.
- When backing- observe the berm and the back edge of your wheels.
- Stop at a safe distance from the berm. Do not use the berm as a brake.
- Always wear your seatbelt!
