Provide employees with soap and clean towels.

Wash work clothing on a daily basis.

Clothing that becomes contaminated during the work day should be changed.

Do not eat or drink in the work area.

Showering/Bathing should be done on a daily basis after each workday.

Clean and sanitize coffee cups and other drinking cups on a daily basis.
